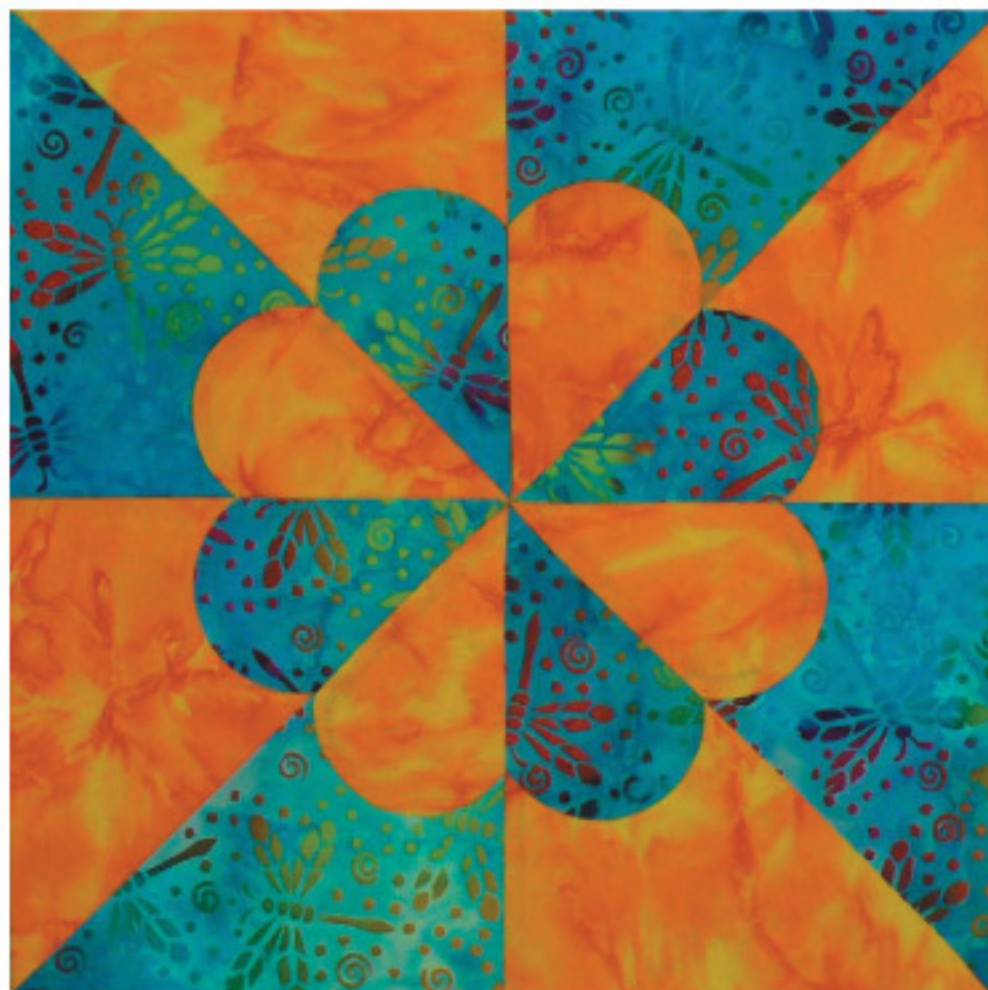
Equipment needed:

Sewing machine.
A single needle plate for your sewing machine.
Size 75 machine embroidery needles.
Piecing thread (beige or gray).
Basic sewing Kit.
Hard pressing Mat.
Regular spray starch. (No spray sizing)
Freezer paper.
Medium stencil brush (Medium).
Water Soluble Basting Glue
Permanent marking pen.
Serge/Surgical tweezers,
Scissors (Paper and fabric scissors).
12 1/2" square ruler.
Rotary cutter and mat.

Iron: You will need your own.

The only one that I find is hot enough to work is a Black and Decker travel iron or a Rowena travel iron. You will need to purchase one. A must no other iron works.

Hard pressing mat.



Supplies Needed:

1/2" yard of of two different fabrics.

This block works well done in scraps.
Use your imagination on the colors you choose.
The brighter the better.
